SCOPE OF PRACTICE

- The comprehensive minimally invasive management of varicose veins using EVLA(Endovenous laser ablation), Ambulatory Phlebectomy(AP) and Ultrasound guided foam sclerotherapy(UGFS), Microsclerotherapy and use of medical adhesives (cyano acrylate).
 - Having done over 2000 cases he is an invited speaker at various national and international meetings on the subject.
- Endovascular management of visceral (renal and mesenteric) and peripheral arterial disease using angioplasty, stenting and atherectomy as a day case or an overnight stay procedure.
- Venous access procedures including Infusaports, PICC lines, Dialysis access (Hickman lines) and endovascular dialysis fistula management.
- Management of varicocoeles and ovarian vein incompetence/ pelvic congestion syndrome using gonadal vein embolisation done as a day case.
- Management of acute haemorrhage (GI,Trauma,Visceral Aneurysm,Haemomptysis) using embolisation
- Management of uterine fibroids using uterine artery embolisation.
- Management of Benign Prostatic Hyperplasia using Prostate Artery embolization as a day case
- Acute back pain management using CT guided Epidural, Nerve root sleeve and facet joint injections.
- Acute Musculoskeletal pain management using Ultrasound and CT guided bursa and joint injections.
- Management of Acute renal and hepatic obstruction using nephrostomy and biliary drainage respectively

 Use of Hyaluron, Platelet Rich Plasma (PRP), Factor 4, Autologous Bone marrow derived mesenchymal stem cells to treat degenerative joint and soft tissue conditions including tendinopathy.
